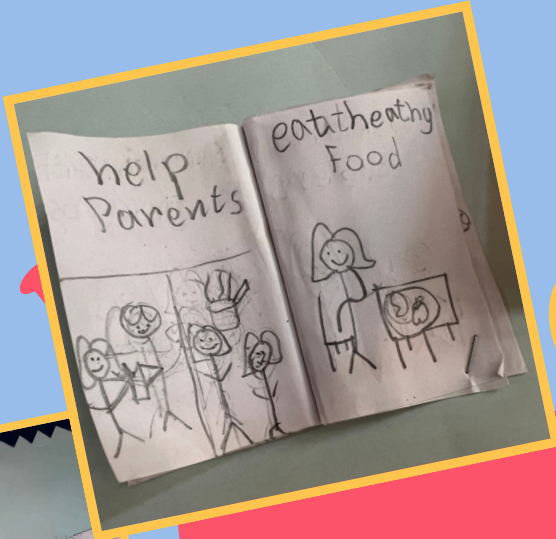
# WELCOME TO *PYP\_2 Ravi!*

- Discussions helped students understand reasons behind these changes.



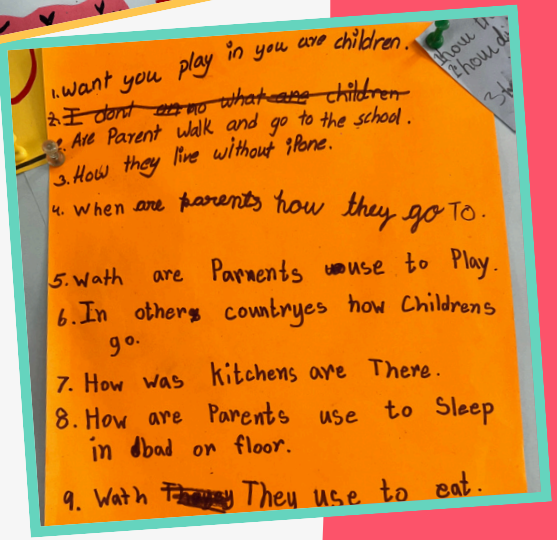
## Tuning In

- They compared past and present childhoods to identify changes over time.

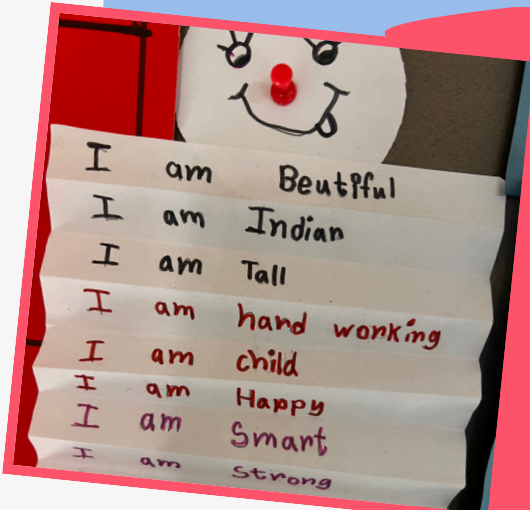


## English Corner:

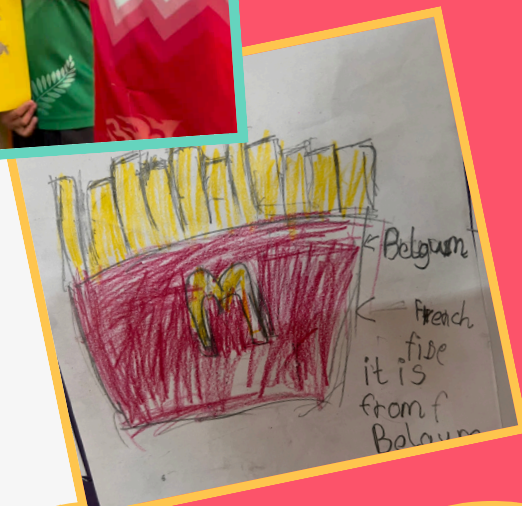
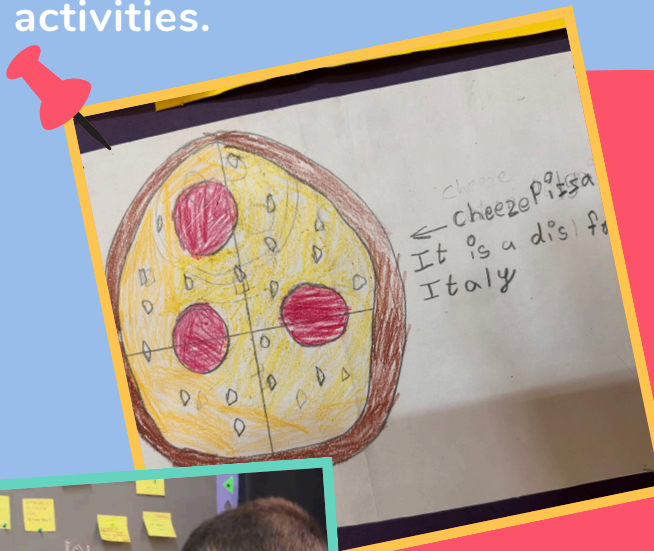
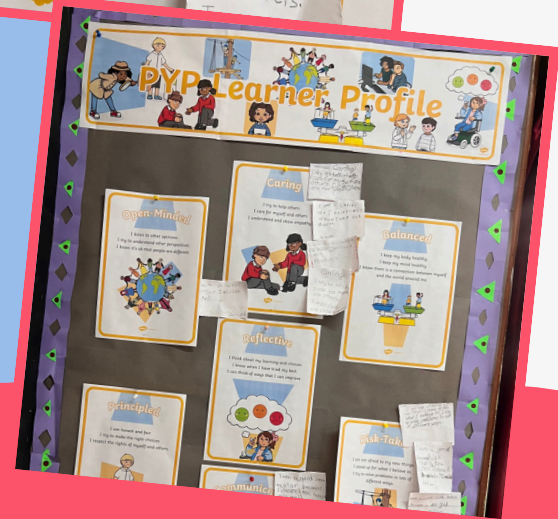
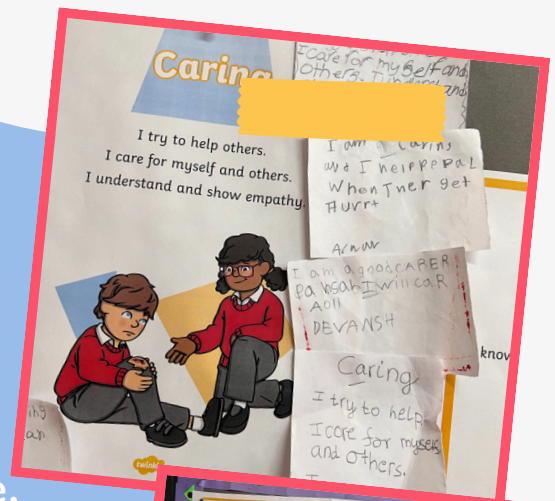
## Numeracy corner:

## Exploring Creativity Through Colours!

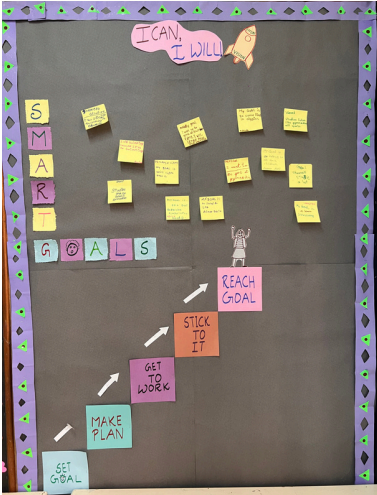

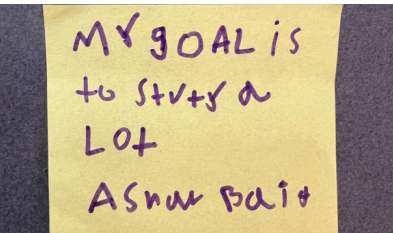
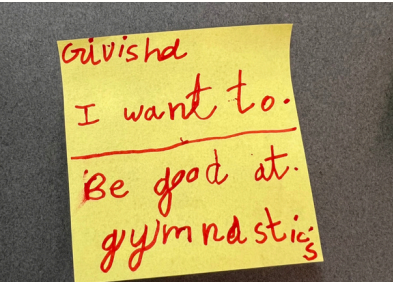
Students have been setting personal learning goals to help them grow as independent learners.



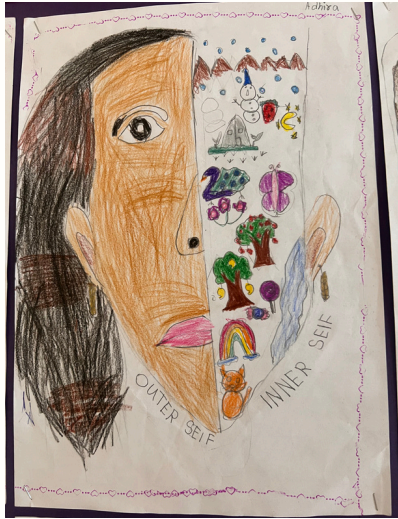
Created posters showing their inner feelings and outer traits



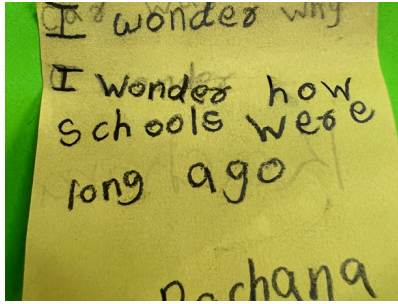
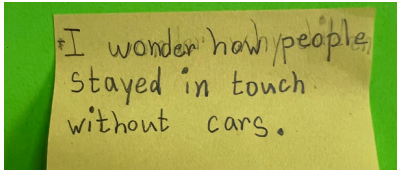
The Wonder Wall celebrates their natural curiosity and helps guide our classroom inquiries.
